Introductions:

Current Business: Support for Staff

Because one of our goals is to provide support for staff as much as possible, the Committee asked SC what kind of help she would require from the Committee (and Board) during events.

SC stated that she would like to have volunteers to help to set up and break down during events. Another important point is that SC will want volunteers to work tables because that would free her to focus on other parts of the event logistics. Also, she needs volunteers who can take pictures during events because then those pictures can be used in the newsletter. Finally, she mentioned that providing contacts or invite people to participate as guest speakers would also be beneficial.

The committee will strive to provide staff with needed help.

→ KY is in charge of letting the Board of Representatives know whenever there is an event that needs volunteers.

Future Business: Membership Meeting

The committee brainstormed ideas on the next Membership Meeting happening in May. KY hopes to make the meeting fun and to have a carnival flavor to it. The committee will continue exploring different ideas to make the next Membership Meeting engaging and fun.

Question Bucket: This is a place to answer any questions about Membership in general

- 1) KY asked the Committee if it would be a good idea to engage entry-level staffers and ask them to participate during events as volunteers, maybe adding the possibility of a stipend.
- -- SC stated that entry-level staffers already help her during events.
- 2) KY asked if it would be a good idea to send personalized handwritten letters to new members as a way of welcoming them into the co-op and make them feel special and engaged. She volunteered to write them all.
- -- The Committee thought it would be a good idea but it is a time consuming task. SC stated she did not have the time to do it but other members said they would be willing to help KY write some cards. In order to protect member information only first names would be provided.
- 3) SC asked if it would be possible to change the method of informing our members regarding the biannual Membership Meetings. At present time the co-op spends \$ 3000 in mailing notices to all members. She asked if members could be given the option to opt-in for electronic communication.
- → ET will take a look at the bylaws and possibly draft a request for the Board to consider adding the paperless opt-in option in the next mailing.
- 4) KY asked if it would be possible to have a big calendar of events visible at the entrance of the store.
- -- The committee commented that there is limited wall space at the entrance of the store.
